- When and where is Camp? Date: June 12 16, 2017 Place: Spring Valley Bible Camp (Address below)
- Bus departs June 12th, Monday from Dunkerton FBC at NOON. <u>Be at the church by 11:45. Please feed your child lunch before you bring them to the church. Lunch WILL NOT be provided.</u> First meal at Camp is at 5pm. We will arrive back in Dunkerton FBC on Friday June 16 at around 4:00pm. Please arrange a ride home for each of your children. Call 231-0516 if you need another option.
- Price: \$150.00 make check to <u>Dunkerton FBC</u> and mark camp in the memo.(Awana attendees & helpers may receive discount!)

Price includes: Meals / Lodging for 4 nights / Basic Activities Supplies / T-shirt

Price does NOT include:

• Snacks – The money you send with your child for snacks will be put into the snack shack bank, they will get to draw on it each time that the snack shack is open. Any balance that is left over at the end of camp will be returned to the camper. More information below on "List of what to pack"

Dress Code:

As you know already, it's HOT in the summer. Please note, parents of kids attending AND the adults attending, everyone should dress modestly during camp. Shorts are definitely encouraged, but please be aware of the length. Females: (children and adults) please refrain from wearing spaghetti straps, halter tops or strapless shirts, additionally, one piece bathing suits are preferred but two piece bathing suits may be covered by tank top or t-shirt. Males: Speedos are not allowed at the pool.

<u>List of what to pack</u> (please mark name on important items)

- * Jacket / Sweatshirt *Shoes (tennis, sandals, etc.) *Bible, notepad, pen, flashlight, sunscreen,
- *Sharpie*Personal items: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo *Towels (3) *Dirty Clothes Bag
- *Snack Money \$10-\$15 needs to be in a sealed envelope, with full name and amount written on front of envelope. Only one envelope per person or family with amounts for each person specified.
- *Optional: bug repellent, visor, sheet music, skits, Instruments or anything needed for talent show
- *Do Not Bring: CD players / radios, electronic games, etc.
- *Important: Medications & Snack Money envelopes will be collected on Monday, 1st day of camp
- *Counselors: optional extras for your cabin: alarm/radio, fan, umbrella & extension cord.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE INFORMATION (for Church Leader only)

Registration begins April 1, 2017. <u>Before you make copies</u>, the form that reads <u>Camper Registration/Medical</u> Form - will need church information filled in. <u>EVERYONE</u> (children, teachers, dorm supervisors, pastors, nurses, etc.) who will be attending camp <u>must</u> turn in a completed registration form.

After Forms are filled out, **SIGNED**, and returned to your church office, send them with the grand total check made out to 'Spring Valley Bible Camp' by May 22, 2017 to: **Julie Behrens (address below)**

*Dorm Supervisor (DS) Requirements: Each church will be responsible for providing male and female DORM SUPERVISORS from their church. If your church cannot provide dorm supervisors, you will need to contact another church to make supervision arrangements for your campers (or call me, I may be able to help). The dorm supervisors will be responsible for transportation, behavior, enforcement of rules, and supervising the campers while they are at camp.

*Dorm Supervisor Qualifications – All dorm supervisors must be at least 18 years of age by the date you attend camp and must stay in the dorm with the youth/**children. Qualifications also include being a born again, growing Christian, a genuine love for the campers, ability to get along well with others and willingness to help wherever needed.

**Camper Limitations – Children who have not completed the 2nd grade or are younger than 7 years old can not stay in the dorms unless approved by the Camp Director.

Spring Valley is NOT equipped for the mentally/physically handicapped persons.
